

How to Add a Sepsis Awareness Month Temporary Profile Picture

Sepsis Alliance is excited to offer two temporary profile picture filters to raise awareness during Sepsis Awareness Month.

When you add a temporary profile picture filter, you have the option to have it expire after a set amount of time. Once your profile picture expires, it'll automatically switch back to your previous profile picture.

You can also add a message to your new profile picture to encourage your friends and followers to join the fight against sepsis. We've included some sample copy below to give you inspiration.



Add a Temporary Profile Filter from your Mobile Phone

1. Go to your profile and tap “**Edit**” on your profile picture
2. Choose “**Add Frame**” and search “**Sepsis**”
3. Choose either Sepsis Awareness Month frame
4. If you'd like, tap “**Make Temporary**”, then select when you'd like the picture to expire
5. Be sure to Drag the corners of the square to crop your photo and tap “**Done**” when you're ready to post your new profile picture.
6. Finally, you can choose to “**say something about your profile picture,**” feel free to use the copy below to show your support of Sepsis Awareness Month

2. Search “Sepsis” for the two Sepsis Awareness Month frame options
3. Adjust the amount of time you'd like the frame to be active and click “**Use as Profile Picture**” to save
