Every 20 seconds someone is diagnosed with sepsis.

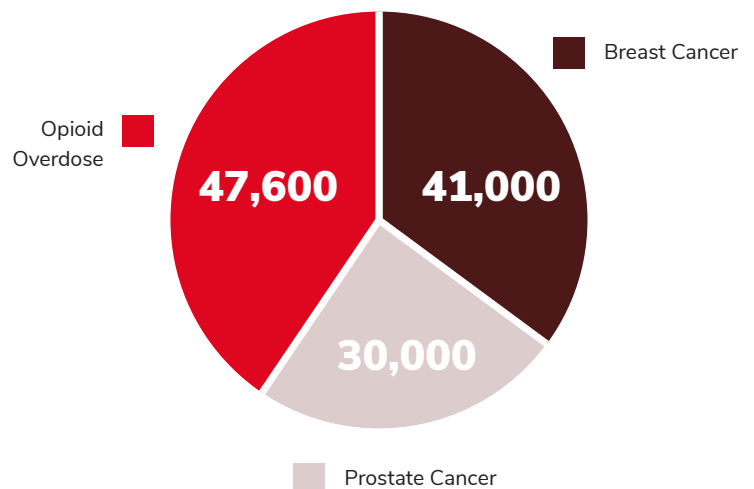
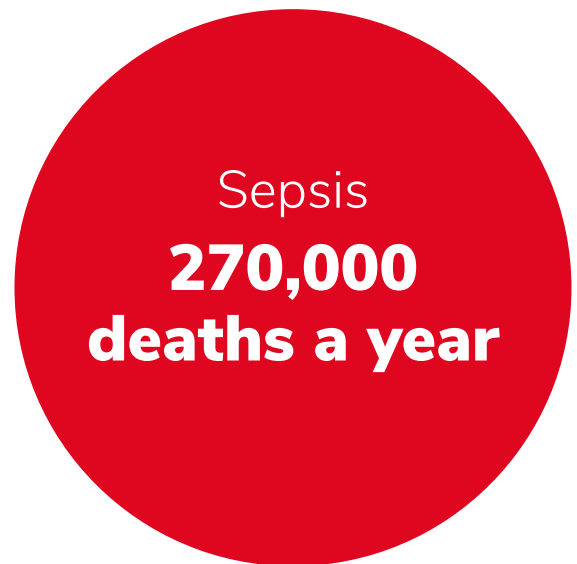


Every 2 minutes sepsis takes a life.
