



BUG SAYS: FINISH YOUR MEDICINE

“If you have an infection, you might have to take some medicine. It’s important to take it all, even if you feel better before it’s all finished.”



If people don't finish taking their medications, the germs might come back and be harder to treat. This is called antimicrobial (ant-eye-my-CRO-bee-al) resistance, or AMR.

You can help prevent AMR by taking your medicine for as long as your doctor said to.
